Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ranjan Gogoi Chancellor

Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ranjan Gogoi was born on 18th November, 1954. He joined the Bar in 1978 and practised mainly in the Guwahati High Court. He was elevated as a Permanent Judge of Guwahati High Court on 28th February, 2001. He was transferred to Punjab & Haryana High Court on 9th September, 2010. He was appointed as Chief Justice of Punjab & Haryana High Court on 12th February, 2011 and the Judge of the Supreme Court on 23rd April, 2012.

Hon'ble Mr.Justice Ranjan Gogoi, a great idealist who expanded the horizons of legal arena and made giant strides in various cases eyed the essence of justice and law in the society and put forward his vision in the form of the foundation of the Maharashtra National Law University, Aurangabad.



Hon'ble Mr. Justice N.V. Ramana

Judge, Supreme Court of India

Justice N.V. Ramana is the member of General Council of the university. He has practiced in the High Court of Andhra Pradesh, Central and Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunals and the Supreme Court of India in Civil, Criminal, Constitutional, Labour, Service and Election matters. He has specialized in Constitutional, Criminal, Service and Inter-State River laws. He has also functioned as Panel Counsel for various Government Organizations. He has functioned as Additional Standing Counsel for Central Government and Standing Counsel for Railways in the Central Administrative Tribunal at Hyderabad. He has also functioned as Additional Advocate General of Andhra Pradesh. He was appointed as a permanent Judge of the Andhra Pradesh High Court on June 27, 2000. He functioned as Acting Chief Justice of Andhra Pradesh High Court from March 10, 2013 to May 20, 2013. He had participated in several National and International Conferences held in India and aboard and submitted papers on various topics of legal importance. He was elevated as the Chief Justice of Delhi High Court September 2, 2013 and further as a Judge of Supreme Court of India February 2, 2014.

Hon'ble Mr. Justice N.V. Ramana enkindled an awakening in the legal stage through leaps and bounds. He is one of the main persons responsible for igniting the torch of legal education by laying down the groundwork of this prestigious university.

Justice Vijaya Tahilramani is the Acting Chief Justice of Bombay High Court. She was enrolled as an Advocate on July 17, 1982. She practised in Sessions Court of Bombay and High Court of Bombay in Criminal, Constitutional and Civil matters but specialised in Criminal law. She worked as a Government Pleader as well as Appellate Side in Bombay High Court. She also worked as a part-time Professor in K.C. Law College, Bombay. She was appointed as an Additional Judge of the Bombay High Court on June 26, 2001. She was appointed as a permanent Judge on October 3, 2004.

Being an undaunted and self-reliant woman who poised various judgements that changed the face of Judiciary, she realised the need of legal expertise in today's world and her allegiance in her career showed a bright path towards the development of our university.



Hon'ble Mr. Justice R.M. Borde
Judge, High Court of Bombay Bench at Aurangabad

Justice R.M. Borde is the Chairman of Infrastructure Committee, Member of Executive & General Council of the University. He was enrolled as an Advocate on 29th October, 1980 and joined the Chamber of his father, a distinguished Advocate practicing on criminal side, late Shri Manoharrao Borde at Beed. On establishment of the Bench of Bombay High Court at Aurangabad, he shifted to Aurangabad in November, 1981 and joined the chamber of Honourable Mr. Justice A. B. Naik and was associated with him for a period of five years. He was the Secretary of the Bar Association, High Court Bench at Aurangabad during the period 1991-92. He has also rendered services as part time Lecturer in M.P. Law College, Aurangabad for a period of two years.

Hon'ble Mr. Justice R.M. Borde, a man who had a distinguished career in the field of law, put his heart and soul in the crux of legal education to evolve this esteemed institution and to sow seeds of towering aims of producing great jurists for our nation.

Justice Sanjay Vijaykumar Gangapurwala is the member of General Council and Infrastructure Committee of the University. After obtaining his LL.B. degree, he started practising in the Trial Court in the year 1985. He further went on to practice at the High Court and Debt Recovery Tribunal. He was associated with various financial Institutions, corporate bodies and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University. He also worked as an honorary part time lecturer at the M.P. Law College. He was appointed as Additional Judge of the Bombay High Court on 13th March 2010.

DIWALI CELEBRATIONS










AURANGABAD AT A GLANCE

The city of Aurangabad is named after the famous Mughal Emperor Aurangzeb. It is also known as the 'City of Gates' as there are about 52 Gates (Darwazas) strewn across the city, each having its own story to tell. The dazzling city of Aurangabad, also called as the Heritage City is a hub of diverse historical attractions. The city was founded in 1610 by Malik Amber which completed 400 years in 2010. Being the fifth largest city in Maharashtra, this time honoured destination arresting the attention of various people around the world is the tourist capital of Maharashtra. Standing tall amidst the whirlwind of metropolitan cities, the City of Gates continues to unfold the legends of the past to the world.



Bibi ka Maqbara

Having a striking resemblance to the Taj Mahal, the Bibi ka Maqbara is a beautiful mausoleum of Rabia-ul-Daurani alias Dilras Banu Begum, the wife of Mughal emperor Aurangzeb. It was constructed by Aurangzeb for his late wife. This magnificent edifice stands tall and proud amidst the vivacious city of Aurangabad.



Ajanta Caves

The Ajanta caves is a set of 30 rock cut Buddhist caves that date back to the period of second century BC.Previously, it was used as a retreat by the Buddhist monks. The caves depict the serenity of Buddhism through its breathtaking and elegant sculpture.



Daulatabad Fort

The town of Daulatabad, once known as the Devgiri meaning the Hill of the Gods is often hailed as one of the 'seven wonders of Maharashtra'. This architectural marvel is believed to have been built in twelfth century. The most distinctive quality of this historical asset is its location, from the zenith of which one can get a mesmerising view of the entire city. It is built on a 200 metres high conical hill which provides a strategic location for this grand fortress, further enhancing its architectural beauty.



Ellora Caves

The monument was carved out of the vertical face of the Charanandri hills. It was built by the glorious Rashtrakuta Dynasty and partly by the Yadava Dynasty. There are twelve Hindu, seventeen Buddhist and five Jain caves. One of the largest rock cut monastery temple and a world heritage site of UNESCO, this magnificent piece of art leaves an important mark in the pages of history of India.



Grishneshwar Temple

The Grishneshwar Temple, also known as the Ghrneshwar Jyotirlinga or Dhushmeshwar Temple is one of the twelve jyotirlinga shrines in India. It is an important pilgrimage site in Shaivism tradition of Hinduism which considers it as the last or twelfth jyotirlinga. This stunning piece of art is a unique example of Bhoomija architecture influenced by the Maratha style.
