Objectives of the Centres:

The prime objectives of Centre for Financial Services will be to become a gateway for the people to enter into financial services. Students after their class XII or graduation who wish to be part of financial services sector will be offered various programs to pursue and enhance their employability into the financial services sector. The centre will impart the cross functional knowledge of Law and financial services to the working professionals for better employment prospects.

The centre will also help to increase the financial literacy on savings, insurance and investments among Indian citizens across all the talukas of India by conducting training, arranging awareness camps, etc. The centre will also organize training programs for the

employees of government agencies on various financial services and their regulations along with frauds and crimes.

The centre will be helping the budding entrepreneurs by providing consultancy services and hand holding to them on fund raising, management of finances and on all types of compliances required by the regulatory authorities. The Centre will also conduct various training and management development programmes (MDP) to cater the needs of corporate sector.

The centre will also undertake research activities to increase the financial literacy among Indian citizens. Along with analysing and evaluating the impact of various policies and provide suggestions to the government agencies on the same.

Proposed Offerings/Activities of the Centre

The centre will offer MBA programme, certifications and diploma courses in all vernacular languages (in ODL and blended learning mode) and also offering short duration certifications/training programmes to the individuals willing to enter the world of financial services. It will organize awareness camps, hands on practice workshops, train the trainers program to conduct training sessions in all talukas of entire India. Training program will be conducted for the employees of Indian services and other State Government officials in coordination with various sector regulators and agencies such as Enforcement Directorate (ED), Serious Fraud Investigation Office (SFIO) and Department of Revenue Intelligence (DRI). It will reach out to budding entrepreneurs through various incubation centres and entrepreneurship cells and help them by creating a central platform through which all their compliance issues will be addressed and manage. Furthermore, centre also renders

customized services for all financial and managerial issues faced by entrepreneurs. Centre will enter into MoUs with various institutions of national importance like IIMs, Institute of Fashion Technology, etc. to conduct tailor made training program and MDPs to suit to requirement of SMEs and large corporate to grow global. Centre will recruit various researchers under Ph.D./ Post Doctoral research / Short term research programmes to boost the research activities.
